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ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

The activity of C.A.S. S.p.A. is production and marketing of fruit juices, in particular juices, concentrates and purees. A considerable part of the production is destined for export. All the activities of the Company are performed at the Castagnaro (VR) site, i.e. production, administration and sales.

C.A.S. S.p.A. is an autonomous Company within GROUP STEINHAUSER, which has other production sites in Europe and shareholdings in South America within the same sector.

While performing its activities the Company C.A.S. S.p.A. commits itself to:

- *comply with all relevant environmental legislation and regulations;*
- *pursue continual improvement aimed at reducing environmental impacts at a level corresponding to "economically viable application of best available technology".*

Within this scope, after having conducted a profound Initial Environmental Analysis of the operational activities, C.A.S. S.p.A. has identified priority areas of action and has set the following objectives:

- *implement an Environmental Management System satisfying all the requirements contained in UNI EN ISO 14001;*
- *communicate to the public and other interested parties all the information necessary for the understanding of the environmental implications of the Company's activities as well as pursuing an open dialogue;*
- *promote responsibility of the employees at each level towards environmental protection as well as to implement programs to inform and train the personnel;*
- *secure the co-operation with official authorities;*
- *communicate the eco-management commitment in order to increase the environmental protection awareness of the suppliers and, if contractually defined, control their environmental management;*
- *contractors working on the site on behalf of the Company must apply environmental standards equivalent to those of the Company;*
- *evaluate the environmental impact of raw materials and auxiliaries and to analyze the environmental impacts before implementing new or modified processes for an improved environmental compatibility;*
- *prevent and mitigate the impact of the Company's activities on soil and surface and groundwater;*
- *control polluting emissions to the atmosphere;*
- *improve waste management;*
- *improved efficiency of water resource management throughout the production cycle;*
- *control the consumption of energy resources and CO₂ emission in accordance with Emission Trading;*
- *adopt necessary measures to reduce the environmental impacts connected with emergency situations.*
